GUIDELINES FOR ABSTRACT SUBMISSION

Abstract Submission Rules and Deadline

All abstracts must be submitted via **Webropol** survey only (visit <https://www.webropolsurveys.com/S/F652C547F231DA31.par>). Abstracts submitted by e-mail, fax or post will NOT be accepted. In submitting the abstract, the author grants the organizers of ICCH16 the right to publish the abstract in the electronic abstract book at the congress web page. The submitted abstracts will remain the property of the ICCH16 Congress. The abstract submission period is from **30th September, 2014** to Thursday **15th January, 2015**.

Abstract Acceptance Notification

Notification of acceptance/rejection will be sent via e-mail to the corresponding author within the period of **1st December, 2014** to **1st March, 2015**. Early abstract submissions will receive earlier notification. If you have not received the e-mail notification by 1st of March 2015, please contact the ICCH16 organizing committee secretariat at thule@oulu.fi. When the abstract is accepted, the author will have to register and pay the congress fee until **15th March, 2015**. All selected presenters who are not registered and paid by this date will not be included in the congress materials.

Abstract Submission Guidelines:

The abstract is subject to reviewing by the Scientific Committee peers. All abstracts must be submitted in English, with written text limited to **2000 characters** (no tables, diagrams, photograph, no formulas, no html-tags, etc. allowed). In the submission survey you must indicate up to two suitable themes for your abstract, and whether you prefer oral or poster presentation. It must detail the title, author's name(s), affiliation, country. E-mail address should be given only for the corresponding author.

The abstract should be short, concise, and understandable to all readers. The Chicago Manual of Style shall be used for references and citations. You can find details for this style at the link http://www.chicagomanualofstyle.org/tools_citationguide.html. Up to three references may be included after the main body of the abstract.
